# INFANT MORTALITY REDUCTION INITIATIVE ELIMINATING DISPARITIES IN PERINATAL HEALTH

Healthy Start is administered by the Health Resources and Services

Administration (HRSA). Healthy Start aims to improve health outcomes before, during, and after pregnancy; and, to reduce racial and ethnic disparities in rates of infant death as well as negative health outcomes in the first 18 months of life.

The Healthy Start Program supports families and empowers caregivers by promoting positive prenatal health behaviors, educating caregivers on nurturing parenting practices, promoting positive fatherhood and male involvement, and sharing information and community resources that increase access to care.

Services include home visitation, case management, health education, child passenger safety education, depression screening, lactation consultation for breastfeeding women, in-home counseling, and referrals to appropriate agencies for wrap around services. These FREE services enhance the quality of life for individuals and families by improving chances for a healthy birth, preparing parents for labor and delivery, and providing information to help meet the challenges of parenting a newborn and toddler.
